#### COVID UPDATE

As we read about the increase in COVID-19 cases in throughout the Sydney region, our school will continue to operate with our baseline COVID-smart measures in place throughout Term 4 to minimise transmission and keep our school open. This includes a combination of layered safety measures such as maintaining hygiene and cleaning practices, using rapid antigen testing (RAT) when experiencing symptoms, maximising natural ventilation and strongly encouraging mask-wearing particularly when indoors and/or physical distancing is not possible.

Please continue to notify the school if your child tests positive to COVID-19 as we will continue to notify the school community of any known positive cases to prioritise student and staff safety and wellbeing.

Students and staff must continue to stay home when sick. Students, staff and visitors should only attend school when they are symptom free. We strongly encourage all students, staff and visitors to follow the guidance issued by NSW HealthExternal link. We will continue to send home students or staff displaying symptoms.

## NEW UNIFORM



#### **HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE?**

As has previously been communicated to the school community, Northmead Public School will have a new uniform from 2023. The transition to this new uniform is expected to take up to 3 years between 2023 and 2025.

#### WHAT CAN STUDENTS WEAR IN TERM 4 2022?

We appreciate that school uniforms may be getting small or worn out towards the end of this year as families may have been holding off on buying new uniforms until the new items are available. During Term 4 it will be acceptable for students to wear their sports uniform on days other than their normal sport days in the event they do not have an academic uniform available to them.

### WILL IT BE OK TO WEAR THE OLD UNIFORM NEXT YEAR?

Yes. Students may continue to wear the current uniform during the 2023-25 transition. The current uniform will not be restocked by the Clothing Shop. Second-hand options may also be utilised during this transition.

## CAN STUDENTS WEAR A COMBINATION OF OLD AND NEW UNIFORM?

Yes! For example:


- If you are in need of new shorts but your grey boys shirts still fit, pair the shirts with our new navy shorts!
- If you still have a tunic that fits, wear it on alternate days to a set of the new uniform!
- Winter tunic still fits but need a new shirt, pair it with the new academic polo until ready to purchase the skort or pants for Winter.

### Phase 1 - Academic Uniform

Our new academic short and long sleeve polo shirts and navy shorts and trousers with elastic drawstring waists are **gender neutral** and are available to all students.

A navy gaberdine skort with built in stretch undershorts is replacing both the Summer and Winter tunics. This can be worn year round with the addition of navy stockings/tights underneath for the colder months. Our existing navy jazz pants for girls will remain for girls who prefer this fit to our unisex trouser option.

Students will wear white socks with black closed toe shoes with the academic uniform.

















### Phase 2 - Sports Uniform

Our sports uniform will remain the same with the exception of a new sports polo to be introduced in phase 2 of our uniform update. The new shirt will be phased in over time later in 2023-2024 as current stock levels of our existing polo shirt run out.

Kindergarten 2023 will be issued our current sports polo from existing stock and will be able to purchase the new shirt/design in larger sizes when it becomes available.

Our sports uniform is royal blue and includes gender neutral microfibre shorts and track pants as well as a four way stretch microfibre skort with built in stretch undershorts option for girls.

Students will wear white socks and sports shoes and sports uniform.

Royal blue sun safe hats will remain part of our uniform.



#### **NSW GOVERNMENT BACK TO SCHOOL VOUCHERS**

NPS P&C have registered The Clothing Shop as a supplier for the NSW Government Back To School Voucher program for 2023.

This will mean that from January 2023 vouchers can be used to purchase school uniform items online from the Clothing Shop.
