



MEET THE TEACHER - Week 5

Thank you for your feedback around the initial "Meet the Teacher" Day in Week 5. This is NOT a separate parent/teacher interview situation. It is meeting your child's teacher face-to-face, seeing their classroom, updating your contact details as well as advising your class teacher if you would like a meeting with your teacher in Term 1 to talk about your particular concerns/information about your child and their learning journey in Term 1 and beyond. There will be information booklets provided on the day but also emailed to families. We ask for your updated confirmation of contact information to ensure we have your up-to-date:

- Parent/Carer Mobile Phone Numbers
- Emai
- Monday-Friday Drop Off/Pick-up
 Arrangements (which we know can vary for our families we need to know what is happening for your child/children EVERY day!)

AFTERNOON PICK UP TIME IS 3PM PLAYGROUND | YOUR GATE OF CHOICE OR KISS AND DROP

Students need to be picked up at the bell time of 3pm. Students will be brought to the Office and parents /carers contacted if they are not picked up by 3:00pm. Contact the office by 2:45pm if you are going to be delayed unexpectedly.

Please use the Kiss and Drop Zone safely. <u>It is NOT an</u> <u>area to park and leave the car</u>. Please be patient in the afternoons as Kleins Road is a very busy area.

If you are meeting your child at a gate, please check that they know which gate to go to. If siblings are meeting each other first, check that each child knows where to meet. Pick an easy-to-find area such as their new classroom, rainbow fence, the school bell or the Kindergarten undercover area.


